We demonstrated the coupling of different sets of linking devices with repositories such as Google Health and HealthVault, with the Continua Certified UA-767PBT-C and UC-321PBT-C communicating with a PC, along with an Android phone supported by LNI, USA. The EC-type approved AD-6121APBT medical scale prototype wirelessly connected with a Sony Vaio PC running Bluetooth Stack for Windows by Toshiba. The transferred weight data was displayed using Digital Note2, an application from Intel Japan.

We invited Dr. Gerold Porenta from Medmobile, Austria, for his Nokia E50 mobile phone application with UA-767PBT. Also invited was Dr. Günter Schreier of the Austrian Institute of Technology, who gave CeBIT visitors a presentation about his work using the NFC version of the UA-767PBT for CHD.

During the exhibition week, about 250 people measured their blood pressure with the UA-767PBT and saw the result on the Web at <u>www.medmobile.at</u>.

At a near-by exhibition stand, Robert Bosch Medical demonstrated a home health console with the UA-767PC.
