- (2) Fill in with an arbitrary 3-digit serial number.
  - If several additional pages are used, this number is used as an identification number. Alternatively, this number can also be used as a submission number.

- (3) Use these numbers as the "current page number / total number of pages" for when additional pages are used.
  - Fill in as: Current page number / Total page number.
  - When no additional pages are used, leave this blank.

We, A&D Company, Limited, request suppliers to submit advance notice to the Purchasing Department of A&D Company, Limited (hereinafter called A&D) before implementing 4M changes for your own reason or your business partner's reason if such changes fall under the standard of the following table.

For changes related to safety and/or quality, A&D may request suppliers to provide documents as the evidence. Also, A&D will request chemical material data in case of any change of component or material.

- \* Packaging and Packaging waste Directive (94/62/EC); the maximum permitted concentrations of Lead, Mercury, Cadmium, and Hexavalent Chromium is 100 ppm or less (weight ratio)
- \* Until RoHS is revised, six (6) substances from number 1 to 6 are to be regulated. The grace period, for preparation, ends and the revised RoHS goes into effect, 10 substances are to be regulated. However when customer requests the testing of substances, testing will be conducted.

#### Chemical substances banned from use (by laws and regulations other than RoHS or by customer's requirements, and others)

If no intentional use of banned substances is confirmed throughout the supply chain with documents such as the certificate of non-use, in that case it is not necessary to analyze the substances. When something containing impurity is found, additional measures may be taken.
